

AGD – WTD Submission Kit Workshop (eGUMIS)

On 6 May 2025, the Unclaimed Moneys Management Division (BWTD) issued an announcement stating that, following the Unclaimed Moneys (WTD) Amendments Act 2024 which took effect on **1 August 2024**, a series of hybrid workshops (physical and online) scheduled will be held to guide companies on WTD submissions using the eGUMIS system.
